### **What will the programme cover?**

The Certificate in Radio, Television and Presenting is a full-time, 34 week introduction to career options available in the film and television industries. There is particular emphasis on the presentation and performance aspects.

Content includes an introduction to copywriting and producing for radio; the skills needed to make a short DVD and radio programme including correct equipment handling practises; voice production and performance techniques; broadcast law and ethics; make-up for presenting on stage and on camera; career and further study options.

### **Entry Criteria**

There are no academic entry requirements for this programme.

Applicants will be required to attend an interview to assess suitability for the programme and applicants with English as their second language must have an IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent.

### **Further Study Options**

Graduates may wish to apply for entry onto higher-level programmes delivered by Aoraki Polytechnic such as the Diplomas in Radio or the Certificate in Film and Television. Qualifications in Performing Arts are available throughout New Zealand.
