

Aoraki Leaders Scholarships

Aoraki Leaders Scholarships are to be awarded to students who are progressing from Aoraki Polytechnic onto a degree programme at another tertiary provider in New Zealand where a formal pathway exists between the two institutions.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must have successfully completed a programme of study in the current year at Aoraki Polytechnic.
- Applicants must be intending to enroll in a degree programme at another tertiary provider in New Zealand where a formal pathway exists between the two institutions.
- Applicants must be a New Zealand resident/citizen.

Award:

A maximum allocation of \$5000 per student will be awarded. The scholarship is designed to assist students meet the cost of tuition fees.

Payment:

The scholarships will be paid in a 1 X \$5000 increment. This payment will be made at the beginning of the second semester conditional on successful completion of the first semester.

Committee Decision:

Applications will be considered by a panel including at least one members of the Aoraki Polytechnic Council, at least one member of the Senior Management Team and one Senior Academic Staff member.

Application Process:

Students wishing to apply for the scholarship must complete the application form (available from Student Advisors or online at www.aoraki.ac.nz) in full and include a written endorsement from their programme tutor/Team Leader.

Timing:

Applications must be received on the official application form to Aoraki Polytechnic by 5.00pm on 11 November 2011. Late applications will not be accepted. The scholarships will be announced at the Graduation Ceremony.

Validation:

The award of a Scholarship shall become void within 2 weeks after receiving official advice unless the recipient completes and forwards the Acceptance and Agreement Contract to the Aoraki Polytechnic Scholarship Coordinator that states:

- The Recipients acceptance of the Scholarship as stated in the Terms of Reference associated with this Scholarship.
- Agreement to participate in specified promotion as per Terms of Reference.
- The Recipients intention of pursuing the programme of intended study set out in his/her application.

Privacy:

The award of the scholarship may be acknowledged in the local newspapers, website, posters and advertising by Aoraki Polytechnic.
